3. Review Recommendations in preparation for Town Council Meeting

- Ken Freidenberg reported that the fourth recommendation was followed up with an administrative meeting with the Town Manager, Superintendent of Schools, Executive Director of the Health District, Police Lieutenant representing the Police Chief, Highway Superintendent and Director of Human Services. Issues discussed included vandalism, property maintenance, mental health, domestic violence, quality of life and use of JRB for early intervention. There was further discussion about the recent vandalism at the New Meadow Path. The Police will publicize a reward and Town Manager will explore using video cameras to identify vandals.
- The Committee reconfirmed the recommendations and discussed their approach to presenting them to the Town Council. The Town Council meetings for June 27 and August 10 have been cancelled but a Special Meeting is scheduled for August 3. A decision will be made on July 20 if CCS will be included as an agenda item for August 3.
