PICNIC RENTALS

Picnic rentals are available from late April through early October and are limited to Newington families, organizations and businesses.

Walk-in registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Phone reservations will not be accepted. Proof of residency is required.

With your rental, you have access to restrooms or portable restrooms, children's playscape, horseshoe pits, and tennis, basketball, bocce and volleyball courts. Swimming is available (fees apply) during recreational swim times which are posted on the website and in our brochure. The softball field can also be reserved on Saturdays and Sundays for a two-hour period. Each picnic area has a large charcoal grill and picnic tables.

Beer and wine is allowed in cans and bottles only. No kegs or hard liquor allowed. Parking is not allowed inside the picnic areas.

Please note that inflatable structures, including slides and bounce houses, are not allowed in any town parks.

2010 DAILY RENTAL RATES

- Lower Area: \$50
- Middle Area: \$75
- Upper Area: \$35 (no shelter)

RENTAL OPTIONS

Lower: This area is located right behind the pond. This rental area has:

- A small shelter
- Electricity
- Picnic tables
- A large charcoal grill
(60-Person Limit)

Middle: This area is located in the center of the park near the playground.

This rental area has:

- A large shelter
- Electricity
- Picnic tables
- A large charcoal grill
(150-Person Limit)

Upper: This area is located near the tennis courts. This rental is an open site.

The rental area has:

- A large picnic table
- A large charcoal grill
(40-Person Limit)

History of Churchill Park

In 1931, Churchill Park was gifted to the Town of Newington from Charles Dudley Seymour who was a descendant of the Churchill family.

After the park was acquired, the brook which ran through it was dammed to make a swimming area. Shortly after, two tennis courts were built. Churchill Park presently houses an outdoor pool, various sports fields & courts, bocce, a nature trail and pavilions.
