PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

June 22, 2021

This hearing was presented as a Zoom Webinar/Meeting

To provide an opportunity for the public to comment and express their views on the an Application received under the Neighborhood Assistance Act.

Mayor DelBuono called the Public Hearing to order at 6:40 p.m.

- Dianne Stone stated that this is a statutory program of the state administered by the Department of Special Revenue. It allows tax-exempt organizations to submit applications for qualifying projects. The town acts as an agent of the state in the process. DRS will review the application to determine whether it meets the statutory requirements and qualifies. At that point, the applicant can seek out business to get a tax credit for making a cash contribution to the project. It's an energy related project and is eligible for a 100% tax credit.
- Frank Stellato stated that they are looking to add photovoltaics as an energy source at Victory Gardens reducing operating expenses for the facility and the families who live there.
