School Construction Project Objectives

Preparing the Next Generation of World Leaders


 Upgrades of the school to comply with School Safety Infrastructure Council guidelines


 Improvements to the building envelope systems (roof, windows, doors, canopies)

 Replacement of the existing MEP systems (HVAC, Electrical, Plumbing, and Fire Alarm)


 Upgrades to interior finishes (flooring, ceilings, and millwork)


 Removal of any hazardous materials within the school

 Project cost after state reimbursement will be between \$16-\$19 million. Net impact to taxpayers will be less than \$75/year after 2023

 Installation of a new elevator to improve the circulation between levels

 Technology Improvements

 Site improvements (vehicular circulation, drainage, pedestrian safety)

 Programmatic improvements to the school
