Platinum Sponsorship: \$3,000

A platinum sponsorship would indicate that the sponsor is the title sponsor for the event and its logo would be **featured on the front** of all **volunteer** and **runner** T-shirts. Further, the platinum sponsor would be recognized on the race registration form, on the Library's website and on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **On-site banners (2) at either start/finish line/awards area (sponsor provides) plus exhibition space at event. Eligible for six (6) complimentary race entries.**

Presenting Sponsorship: \$2,500

A presenting sponsorship would indicate that the sponsor is specifically recognized as being the sponsor for the presentation of the awards. The sponsor would also be **prominently recognized on the back** of the T-shirts, the race registration form, on the Library's website, and on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **On-site banners (2) at ceremony area (sponsor provides) plus exhibition space at event. Eligible for five (5) complimentary race entries.**

Finish Line Sponsorships \$1,500 (more than one can apply)

A finish line sponsorship would indicate that the sponsor is specifically recognized as being the sponsor for the finish line/chutes.

Finish Line Sponsorships (continued)

The sponsor would also be **recognized on the back** of the T-shirts, the race registration form, on the Library's website, and on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **On-site banner (1) at finish line (sponsor provides) plus exhibition space at event. Eligible for four (4) complimentary race entries.**

Hospitality Sponsorships: \$1,000 (more than one can apply)

A hospitality sponsorship would indicate that the sponsor is specifically recognized as being the sponsor for race hospitality and refreshments. The sponsor would also be **recognized on the back** of the T-shirts, the race registration form, on the Library's website, and on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **On site banner (1) at refreshment area (sponsor provides) plus exhibition space at event. Eligible for four (4) complimentary race entries.**

Little Readers Sprint: \$750 (more than one can apply)

A sponsor for this category is specifically recognized as being the sponsor for the Little Readers Sprint. The sponsor would also be recognized on the back of the T-shirts, the race registration form, on the Library's website, and on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **One site banner (1) prominently displayed (sponsor provides) plus exhibition space at event. Eligible for four (4) complimentary race entries.**

Gold Sponsorships: \$500 (more than one can apply)

A gold sponsor's logo is included **on the back** of the T-shirts, and will receive recognition on our application forms, a listing on the Library's website, and a listing on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **Eligible for three (3) complimentary race entries.**

Silver Sponsorships: \$250 (more than one can apply)

A silver sponsor will receive recognition on our application forms, a listing on the Library's website, and a listing on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **Eligible for two (2) complimentary race entries.**

Newington CHEERS Sponsorships: \$150 (more than one can apply)

A Newington CHEERS Sponsor (Newington Community Helps & Encourages Eager Running Students) will receive recognition on our application forms, a listing on the Library's website, and a listing on the sponsor board that will be on display at the race and for two weeks in the lobby of the Library. **Each sponsor at the CHEER level will provide 4 complimentary entries for Newington students in grades 5 through 8 to encourage Newington youth to run.**
