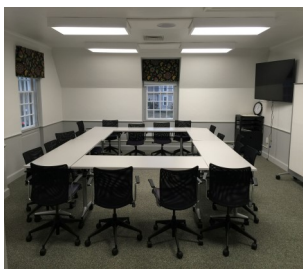
NOTARY SERVICE - Free and available to the public.
