Frequently Asked Questions

Who can use the Books-For-You service?

You are eligible for Books-For-You if you are homebound and unable to visit the Library in person. Individuals requesting this service must live in Newington and have, or be eligible for, a valid library card from the Lucy Robbins Welles Library. Residents of a Newington healthcare facility are also eligible for this service.

How do I apply?

Please fill out the application on the back of this brochure or call us at 860-665-8707 to have an application mailed to you. Completed applications can be mailed or faxed to the Library. After your application is processed, our Homebound Services Coordinator Michelle will contact you to discuss your reading or listening interests and help you with your selections. Then we'll deliver the materials to you.

How does the service work?

The materials you request will be delivered to your home by a Library staff member or volunteer. Materials will be checked out to your Lucy Robbins Welles Library card for 4 weeks. If you do not already have a card, the Library will issue you one. When you have finished with the materials, you must call the Library to have the items picked up and to let us know if you would like more items. While you are exempt from overdue fines, you will be responsible for the replacement cost of any lost or damaged materials.
