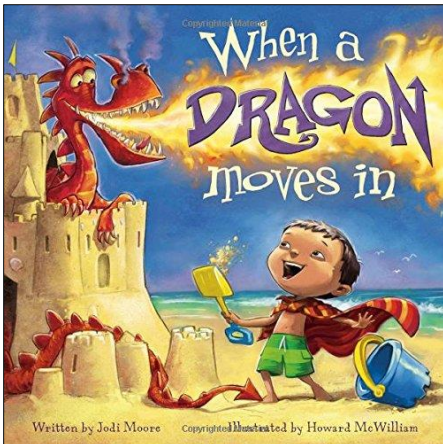

2. Choose an activity (or two) from the list below:

— DRAW OR PAINT a dragon.

What will your dragon look like? If you would rather, draw your own mystical, magical, made-up creature from your own imagination.

— BAKE a batch of brownie.

Choose a homemade recipe or use a box mix. Share the brownies with your family and your dragon of course.

— BUILD a sandcastle.

You're not going to the beach? That is okay! Build with boxes, blankets, LEGO® bricks or anything you have available that will make a great castle.

— OUTSIDE imagination.

In the story you saw and heard many things: like, the dragon's sharp teeth, a dragon's feather, and smoke from the dragon. Also, the lemonade sizzled and the dragon roared.
